Dear Brothers

We write to you regarding a recommendation for reinstatement for BCH that we have received from the Kalamunda congregation. We have enclosed a copy of the Kalamunda Committees letter along with Mr BCH request for reinstatement. We felt it was prudent to keep you up to date with this latest development and also we would greatly appreciate your observations & comments.

We note that Mr BCH has now confessed to immoral dealings with one of his daughters, yet still is maintaining his innocence of improper dealings with his other daughters. He claims there were either, extenuating circumstances, or his daughters are themselves guilty of lying.


We also note Mr BCH makes repeated references to court cases, and events that happened throughout his life with his daughters, that we find confusing and difficult to understand, since we were not present at the court proceedings and have very limited knowledge of his past.


However it appears to us that Mr BCH has only partially admitted to his sins and has not made restitution with his daughters. Hence we are of the opinion that Mr BCH is still continuing his lies and is not demonstrating true repentance worthy of reinstatement.
